File No. 051458 is a substitute resolution to vacate the 6.5-foot portion of excess sidewalk area along West Pittsburgh Avenue located between the West Side of South 1st Street and the railroad right-of-way, in the 12th Aldermanic District. This vacation was requested by the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee to permit the future sale of land for construction of a 4-story, mixed-use building, development of an outdoor cafe and elimination of a canopy and staircase encroachment.
