File # 060061 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement Grant.

### **Background**

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement project from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance through the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance.
- 2. This is a grant continuation.

# **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of the Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement project is to reduce the volume of controlled substances in the Milwaukee area through the prevention and suppression of illegal drug activity.
- 2. This grant will fund one existing Lieutenant of Detectives position, one new Detective position and 1 new Police Officer position with a portion of salary and fringe benefits.
- 3. \$40,000 is budgeted for confidential funds.
- 4. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006.

## **Fiscal Effect**

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$273,004 with \$209,525 provided by the grantor and \$63,479 provided by the city.
- 2. The city portion of the grant includes the MPD share of salary and fringe benefits per the specifications of the grant award.
