Please allow this letter of correspondence to serve as an official appeal to the 20-day suspension recommended by the licensing committee, passed on June 6, 2006 regarding 2342 W. North Avenue, located in Milwaukee, WI.

It was verified during the June 6th hearing that several items in the police report were fabricated. Also, the staff assistant to the Common Council President supported the evidence that my establishment does not contribute to the cruising in the area; yet, I received a recommendation for a 20-day suspension.

I appeal this decision and request that this matter is reconsidered; however, if the **facts** in this matter are disregarded, I request that this unjust suspension takes place after the July 4, 2006 weekend to accommodate a previously scheduled wedding and family reunion.
