Financial support from We Energies will allow MHD CLPPP grant dollars for window lead abatement to be used to encourage owners to upgrade to insulated windows. The (lead abatement) window work will take the form of installing new insulated Energy Star replacement windows conforming to the CLPPP specifications and standards.

Using \$1,152,000 from the MHD and a proposed \$360,000 from We Energies, the MHD CLPPP proposes to facilitate window replacement/lead hazard reduction in 600 housing units by installing new insulated Energy Star rated replacement windows.
