







District & Corridors Concept Plan

Washington Park Area Plan - District A



- Maintain and extend the value of historic districts and Washington Heights
- Strengthen stability and home ownership of 'Garfield & Lloyd blocks area
- Maximize development opportunities on 'Park View Blocks'
- Improve Sherman/Lisbon/Lloyd Intersection
- United Methodist Expansion
- Support increase activity in Washington Park and better access into the park.

Washington Park Area Plan - District B




- Improve connections between Bethune Academy and Washington Park along Galena Street

Washington Park Area Plan – District C




- Incorporate residential infill and greenspace north and south of Lisbon along the rail corridor

- Activity Node at 35th and North with improved transit facilities





- Hmong-American Friendship Association


