First Amendment to Project Plan

Introduction

Section 66.1105(4)(h)(1), Wisconsin Statutes, permits the Redevelopment Authority, subject to the approval of the Common Council, to amend the project plan for a tax incremental financing district.

Section 66.1105(2)(f)1.n., permits an amendment to fund projects located outside, but within one half-mile of the district's boundary.

The City of Milwaukee created Tax Incremental District Number 20 in 1993 for the purpose of providing financial assistance to fund site assembly, environmental remediation and public improvements for the Florida Yards Industrial Park, a 15-acre site at East Florida and South Water Streets.

To date, \$6,220,033 in project costs have been incurred, including interest on debt and associated carrying charges, and approximately \$4,728,181 of incremental revenue has been generated in the TID.

In summary, Amendment No. 1 to the Project Plan will provide \$450,000 for the purpose of paving a street segment located within one-half mile outside of the current TID boundary. The segment is:

• S. 5th Street between W. Virginia and W. Scott Streets

Amendments to the Project Plan:


