File #060346 is a resolution authorizing and directing the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a document titled "Federal/State/Project Sponsor Transportation, Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Program, Project Agreement" with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for programming of a project known as Bicycle Lane Delineation (Non-highway) Project. (Infrastructure Services Division)

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

- 1. This resolution authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a project agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) for programming of a Bicycle Lane Delineation (Non-highway) project. The project is funded by the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program.
- 2. The purpose of the project is to install bicycle lanes on various roadways throughout the City of Milwaukee.
- 3. The estimated total cost of the project is \$500,000. A breakdown of cost estimate include:

- 4. The attached map shows the potential locations for the bicycle lanes. The final locations will be determined after review with the aldermen.
- 5. The project is expected to begin and be completed within 2006.

FISCAL IMPACT

- 1. The total estimated cost for the 'Federal/State/Project Sponsor Transportation, Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Program, Project Agreement' with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for the Bicycle Lane Delineation (Non-highway) project is \$500,000, with the preliminary engineering estimated at \$20,000. The grantor share of the preliminary engineering costs is \$16,000, 80% and the city-share is \$4,000, 20%
- 2. A resolution will be issued in the future authorizing expenditures for construction costs.
