Dear Committee Members:

Under the terms of the 2004-2007 labor agreement between the City of Milwaukee and the Milwaukee Building and Construction Trades Council (MBCTC), the wage rates for employees covered by this agreement are tied to the outside wage rates of the MBCTC. The MBCTC has provided us with the outside rates that became effective June 1, 2006.

In order to implement the wage rate changes effective Pay Period 16, 2006, as required by the labor agreement, we are requesting your approval of the attached amendments to Section 26 of the Salary Ordinance.

The costs of these amendments were estimated in the fiscal note attached to CC file #021160, because the rates on the outside had not yet been determined. The attached fiscal note contains the difference between the estimated and the actual costs and savings that will result from the new wage rates.
