Substitute resolution extending the due date for the final report and recommendations of the Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund Task Force and changing the date of dissolution of the Task Force.

..Analysis

This resolution amends Common Council File Number 051017 such that the deadline for the Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund Task Force to submit its findings and recommendations to the Common Council is changed from June 13, 2006, to July 31, 2006. It further amends File Number 051017 such that the Task Force will dissolve on the date of final Common Council action on File Number 060071, the resolution relating to recommendations of the task force for the operation and funding of a housing trust fund (previously, the Task Force was to be dissolved upon submission of its findings and recommendations to the Common Council).

..Body

Whereas, On December 13, 2005, the Common Council adopted File Number 051017, a resolution creating a task force to study issues related to establishing a City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund; and

Whereas, This resolution directed the task force to submit its findings and recommendations to the Common Council within 180 days of adoption of the resolution (i.e., by June 13, 2006); and

Whereas, This resolution also stipulated that the task force would be dissolved upon submission of its findings and recommendations to the Common Council; and

Whereas, The Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund Task Force, as it has come to be known, is actively engaged in preparing the report of its findings and recommendations, but may not be able to meet the June 13 deadline; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the final "Further Resolved" clause of Common Council File Number 051017 is deleted and the following 2 "Further Resolved" clauses are inserted to read as follows:

Further Resolved, That the task force shall submit its findings and recommendations to the Common Council by July 31, 2006; and, be it

Substitute resolution creating an affordable housing task force to study issues related to establishing a City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund.

..Analysis

This resolution creates an affordable housing task force to study issues related to establishing a City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund. The task force shall identify and evaluate existing programs that benefit the homeless and economically disadvantaged to avoid duplication of services and identify their funding sources to assess the possibility of a City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund as a qualified program recipient. The task force shall participate in the RFP process to hire a consultant who will assist the task force in its work of defining the structure, goals, objectives, strategies, financial resources and programs for the City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund. The task force shall present its findings and recommendations to the Common Council within 180 days of adoption of this resolution, and shall thereafter be dissolved. ..Body

Whereas, In wake of the various national disasters and global wars, the numbers of homeless and other economically disadvantaged persons are growing; and

Whereas, Private businesses, community-based organizations, city, county and state agencies administer and manage various programs dedicated to ensuring that children and families are provided clean and safe shelter at affordable rents; and

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee continues to support and develop programs that provide quality, safe, affordable housing as a stabilizing factor for those persons and families most in need; and

Whereas, The Common Council in 2000 supported federal legislation designed to create and fund a National Affordable Housing Trust Fund, a bill that did not become law but would have leveraged funds against various publicly and privately run housing programs that serve thousands annually; and

Whereas, On October 18, 2005, the Common Council adopted Resolution File Number 050755, appropriating \$25,000 in non-tax levy funds to hire a consultant, who along with an advisory task force, will help develop the City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund (HTF); and

Whereas, It is the Common Council's intent that the advisory task force conduct various start up tasks including but not limited to, developing a formal structure for the administration of the Housing Trust Fund, recommending guidelines to select and develop worthy projects, and identifying on-going sources of revenue to support future Housing Trust Fund projects; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that a housing task force is created and shall consist of:

- 1. Two members appointed by the Common Council President, one to serve as chair and the other as vice-chair.
- 2. The Mayor or the Mayor's designee.
- 3. The Commissioner of the Department of City Development or the Commissioner's designee
- 4. The Director of the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee or the Director's designee.

- 5. Two members from the Interfaith Conference, appointed by the Common Council President.
- 6. One member from the business community, appointed by the Common Council President.
- 7. One member of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors, appointed by the Common Council President.
- 8. One member from the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Corporation, appointed by the Common Council President.
- 9. One member from the Fair Housing Council, appointed by the Common Council President.
- 10. One member from Independence First, appointed by the Common Council President.
- 11. One member from Continuum of Care, appointed by the Common Council President.

; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Common Council President may appoint others to the task force from the private and public sectors that can assist the task force in reaching its objectives; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the task force shall evaluate and make recommendations relating to the hiring of a consultant and the structure, goals, objectives, strategies, financial resources and programs for the City of Milwaukee HTF; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Clerk's Office shall provide staff support to the task force; and, be it

Further Resolved, That all City departments are authorized and directed to cooperate with and assist the task force in carrying out its mission; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the task force may request assistance from non-City entities in carrying out its mission; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the task force shall submit its findings and recommendation to the Common Council within 180 days of adoption of this resolution, and shall thereafter be dissolved.

File # 051017 is a resolution creating an affordable housing task force to study issues related to establishing a City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund.

Background

- Advocates have requested City assistance in starting up a City of Milwaukee
 Housing Trust Fund to provide decent, safe and affordable housing for the growing
 number of homeless and other economically disadvantaged persons in Milwaukee.
- Via Resolution 041742, adopted April 12, 2005, the Common Council supported establishing a Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund, an affordable housing production program, anticipating funding would be provided from the 2005-2007 state budget as follows:
 - \$1.2 million in real estate transfer fees (Of all real estate transfer fees collected by the County, the County retains 20% and remits 80% to the state; Assembly Bill 100 would have allowed Milwaukee, as a first class city, to receive the 80% of fees collected in conjunction with sales in the city)
 - \$5 million in separate, dedicated authority to fund a City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund if lobbying efforts are successful

Both measures failed at the state level.

- 3. On October 18, the Common Council adopted Resolution File 050755, contributing \$25,000 from the Harassment Settlement Account toward the startup of a City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund by funding costs to hire a consultant that would collaborate with an advisory task force on various tasks, including but not limited to:
 - Developing a formal structure for the administration of the Housing Trust Fund,
 - · Recommending guidelines for selection and development of projects, and
 - Identifying on-going sources of revenue to support the Housing Trust Fund's future projects
- 4. The \$25,000 expenditure for consultant costs requires further Common Council approval by resolution.

Discussion

5. File 051017 authorizes creating an affordable housing task force to assist in hiring the consultant and studying various issues related to establishing a City of Milwaukee Housing Trust Fund. The task force's composition shall be as follows:

- 2 members* of the Common Council, one to serve as chair and the other as vicechair
- Mayor or Mayor's designee
- Commissioner of the Department of City Development or Commissioner's designee
- Director of Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee or Director's designee
- 2 members* from the Interfaith Conference
- 1 member* from the business community
- 1 member* of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors
- 1 member* from the WI Housing and Economic Development Corporation
- 1 member* from Fair Housing Council
- 1 member* from Independence First
- 1 member* from Continuum of Care

6. The task force shall submit a written report of its findings and recommendations to the Common Council no later than 120 days of adoption of this resolution, and dissolve thereafter.

Fiscal Effect

Adopting File No. 051017 has no fiscal impact because it only creates the task force.
