Dear Council Members:

Attached please find a permissory resolution that grants the Washington Heights Neighborhood Association permission to place benches at various bus stops within the neighborhood.

Washington Heights Neighborhood Association is a non-profit organization comprised of area residents working to improve their neighborhood. Currently, the neighborhood association is requesting permission to place and maintain benches in the public right-of-way adjacent to thirteen bus stops. The attached resolution details the proposed locations for the benches, which have been field viewed by Department of Public Works staff. The "bus benches" are being artistically treated by area artists prior to installation.

We are not aware that the presence of the aforementioned bus benches will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way.
