2C. Explain identified hazards such as: Visibility Restrictions, Curves, Hills, Intersection Problems, Bike/Ped Conflicts, Narrow Shoulders, Rutting, Etc.

Thirteen intersections were identified as having a high number of rear-end and disregard of signal crashes. At these intersections, approaches with high numbers of disregards and rear-end crashes were identified for the installation of overhead mast arms, additional near-left housings on median-divided roadways, and larger 12" far right signal housings.

Proposed Improvement

3. In some detail, describe the proposed project and how it will address the identified hazard.

Burleigh and 27th: To improve visibility, overhead mast arms will be installed in all four directions and the far right 12" signal housings will be relocated at an estimated cost of \$22,000.

Burnham and Layton Blvd.: To improve visibility, overhead mast arms with 12" signal housings will be installed in all four directions at an estimated cost of \$27,000.

Center and 27th: To improve visibility, overhead mast arms with 12" signal housings will be installed in

the westbound and southbound directions at and estimated cost of \$14,000.

Clybourn and Water: To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm with a 12" signal housing will be installed in the westbound direction at an estimated cost of \$8,000.

Congress and 76th: To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm with a 12" signal housing will be installed in the northbound direction and far right 12" signal housings will be installed in the eastbound, westbound, and southbound directions at an estimated cost of \$8,000.

Dr. MLK Dr. and W. Locust St.: To improve visibility, overhead mast arms will be installed in all four directions and the far right 12" signal housings will be relocated at an estimated cost of \$16,000. **Hampton and 68th:** To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm will be installed in the eastbound

Hampton and 68": To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm will be installed in the eastbound direction with the 12" signal housing relocated and near left 8" signal housings will be installed in eastbound, westbound, and northbound directions at a total estimated cost of \$8,000.

Lapham and 2nd: To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm with a 12" signal housing will be installed in the westbound direction, and far right 12" signal housings will be installed in the eastbound, northbound, and southbound directions at an estimated cost of \$8,000.

North and Teutonia: To improve visibility, overhead mast arms with 12" signal housings will be and painted left turn lanes will be installed in all four directions at an estimated cost of \$15,000.

Sherman Blvd. and Villard: To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm will be installed in the southbound direction with the 12" signal housing will be relocated and near left 8" signal housings will be installed in the northbound and southbound directions at a total estimated cost of \$7,000.

Vliet and 27th: To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm with a 12" signal housing will be installed in the northbound direction and far right 12" signal housings will be installed in the southbound, eastbound, and westbound directions at a total estimated cost of \$8,000.

Wells and 17th: To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm will be installed in the eastbound direction with the 12" signal housing relocated at an estimated cost of \$8,000.

Wells and 35th: To improve visibility, an overhead mast arm with a 12" signal housings will be installed in the northbound direction and an overhead mast arm will be installed in the southbound direction with the 12" signal housing relocated at an estimated cost of \$15,000.





PROJECT LOCATION MAP





