COMPUTATIONS USED IN ARRIVING AT FISCAL ESTIMATE: Although this resolution does not appear to have a fiscal impact, it does have policy implications. Currently, the DPW requests authority from the Common Council to issue an RFP and to enter into a contract with the winning proposer. This resolution will require DPW to submit the RFP to the Common Council for review and approval prior to soliciting proposals and to submit a contract to the Common Council for review and approval. This is a significant policy change to the current process and could result in a major delay in issuing the RFP and negotiating the contract and has the potential to politicize the RFP and contracting processes.
