This ordinance is a technical revision of the Code to reflect a change relating to the Police Educational Program. It updates the title of Police Commander to Inspector of Police (per a classification study in 2004) and the \$20 increase in educational increment payments granted in 2003 to nonrepresented, sworn management police employees.

Passage of this file increases maximum educational increment payments by \$20, which will authorize increased expenditure of \$140 per year.

Background

- 1. The Police Educational Program provides annual payments for the completion of approved coursework or the possession of an Associate or Bachelor's degree.
- 2. There are 7 positions eligible for the Police Educational Program in section 350-137 of the Milwaukee Code: 1 Chief of Police; 1 Assistant Chief of Police; 3 Deputy Chief of Police; and 2 Inspector of Police.
- 3. It has been DER's practice that benefit changes for the MPSO have been also extended to the nonrepresented, sworn management police employees.
- 4. Effective in 2003, the MPSO received a \$20 increase in each educational increment.
- 5. Passage of this ordinance will codify that change in the Police Educational Program for all 7 eligible positions.
- 6. Passage of this ordinance will also update the title of Police Commander to Inspector of Police, which is a technical change per a 2004 classification study.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

The total increase in expenditure is \$140 per year (\$20 increase in each educational increment per year x 7 employees). Each person eligible for this benefit is receiving the benefit.

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
