Professional Licensing Board Violations



IMPACT 2-1-1 ensures that all clients are connected to appropriate referrals. Once programs and services have been entered into the online database, agency reps receive password-protected access to update their own information as often as changes occur. This is particularly important during a community emergency.

Tracking need. Reporting gaps in service.

Although it is a confidential service, IMPACT 2-1-1 uses the data documented from each service request to track: client demographics; changes in service volume; stated need(s); information and referrals provided; and "unmet" needs resulting from gaps in service. The data collected by IMPACT 2-1-1 helps community stakeholders, policymakers and funders address needs specific to an issue, population or geographic area.

Emergency government, human service systems and community coalitions turn to IMPACT 2-1-1 because of our ability to collect data and disseminate information quickly; as well as to ramp up capacity utilizing the national network of 2-1-1s.
