Property

4243 W. NORTH AV. Former Finney Library Sherman Boulevard Historic District Description of work 4243 West North Avenue is the former Finney Library. The rear or south elevation was utilitarian in appearance as it backed up to residences along Sherman Boulevard. Two residences were subsequently removed south of the library to allow for a parking lot for the library. A low berm and retaining wall were installed between the parking lot and the building, an area about 20 feet wide and 30 inches high.

> The City of Milwaukee shut off utilities to the building after the library relocated to new premises. A new development was constructed directly east of the former library. As a result, electrical service was relocated and power cannot be restored to the former library building at the same location as it had historically. To get power to the former library building and to meet the criteria of the power company, the low berm has to be removed as well as the retaining wall.




All work to be done to meet the requirements necessary to allow for electrical power to be hooked up to the building.


The grounds must be returned to a condition that is orderly and free of debris. The construction of a new entry into the building, fronting the parking lot, will follow in a separate Certificate of Appropriateness once final details are worked out and the Historic Preservation Commission makes its review.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 


Current condition of the former Finney Library. Note retaining wall and berm between building and parking lot.






Site plan showing the path of the electrical installation.
