


All work is to be carried out according to the designs submitted. Sign mountings should not be visible and where installed on brick signage should be installed through mortar joints and not the face of the brick.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 
