Dear City Attorney:

I would like to appeal the decision you made for the repairs for my 2005 STS Cadillac. Everyday I drive to work I usually take 20th street from Melvina to State, however during that month of June, 20th street past North Ave was closed due to road construction. I had to find an alternate route. On June 20th 2007, I decided to take 27th street all the way to State to get to work. When I arrived at Center street I was driving in the right hand lane behind a car. I saw his car dip, but it was to late for me to stop before I actually saw the "man-made hole" and drove in it. This was not a "pothole" as you put it. I got a tape measure and that hole was approximately 3ft by 6ft and about 6in deep. There were no barricades or cones blocking the hole. It appears to me that hole was made to accommodate that new Condo being built. But by me not traveling that route I don't know when the hole was made. However, I do know when I went back to 27th & Center on June 21st @ 4:00 pm to take pictures of the hole, the hole was filled. I didn't take my picture. I did go back a week later and took a picture of the filled hole to show it was a hole there. The damages to my car are \$943.42. The City of Milwaukee is negligent. I have my receipt for the work that was done to my car and I also have the damaged rim. Your investigation shows the Infrastructure Services Division-Field Operations records proved they were out on June 21st and asphalted the "man-made hole". As I noted prior it was not a "pothole". The day the incident happened I called the City to report the "manmade hole" and was told to file a claim with the City and that the City knows of the "man-made hole at 27th & Center. However, she never took my name and I was told no complaints are taken over the phone. I was never told I needed to call the DPW Call Center to file a complaint with them.

Dear Office of City Clerk,

On June 20<sup>th</sup> 2007 at 07:45am, I was driving to work, going south on 27<sup>th</sup> street, on Center before the cross-walk intersection there was a man made hole on the right hand side of the street, larger than 4ft by 6ft. I did not see the hole until it was too late and drove in the hole. There were no cones, signs or barricades blocking the hole in street. I continued on to work. Once there I notice damage underneath my car and a rim bent. I returned to 27<sup>th</sup> & Center on Thurs June 21<sup>st</sup> to take pictures of the hole, it was filled already, within a 24 hour period. I will like the City of Milwaukee to pay for the damages to my 2005 STS Cadillac. Enclosed is a copy of the bill for repairs that was made to my car. I am requesting \$943.42 reimbursement. A picture of the filled-in hole is also enclosed.

The City of Milwaukee was negligent by not having something blocking man-made hole.
