Re: Shooting of Willie Cain

Dear Chief Hegerty:

In the early morning hours of Saturday, October 16, 2004, City of Milwaukee Police officer Kimberly Lastrilla discharged her service weapon 3 times in the direction of Willie Cain, striking him once in the thigh. Cain, who was wielding a hammer and had ignored repeated commands to stop, drop the hammer and get onto the ground, lunged at Lastrilla with the hammer immediately prior to being shot.

This office has conducted a review of that shooting. Based upon that review I have reached the following conclusions.

First, Lastrilla had a subjective belief that the use of deadly force was necessary to prevent imminent death or great bodily harm to herself. Second, this belief was objectively reasonable under the circumstances. Third, therefore, Lastrilla's use of deadly force was privileged as an exercise of self-defense as that term is defined in section 939.48 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
