The above-named police officers have retained us to represent them in connection with the above-referenced matter. Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them, and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This was a traumatic incident regarding a death in custody.

The MPD conducted a criminal investigation and investigated the matter as a critical incident. IAD compelled POs Lemke, Szweda, Boaz, Feather, Cullen Jaeck and Lindsay to give statements after issuing PI-21s. Later, Chief Deputy District Attorney Robert Donohoo concluded that the Officers would not be charged. Attached is a copy of Chief DDA Donohoo's letter and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

Re: The Death of Felix L. Hopgood

On July 24, 2003, Felix L. Hopgood, while in the custody of the City of Milwaukee Police Department, collapsed. Subsequently he was taken to a hospital where he was pronounced dead. Prior to his collapse he had been arrested by one or more City of Milwaukee police officers.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of the results of that investigation by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

My investigation included, but was not limited to, an independent investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding the incident, interviews of persons who had information concerning this incident, a review of the official City of Milwaukee Police Department reports relating to this incident, an examination of the area where the incident occurred, and an examination of the physical evidence.

It is the decision of the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office that no City of Milwaukee police officer or other person will be charged with violating any provision of the Wisconsin Criminal Law in connection with the death of Felix L. Hopgood. The cause of death in this case was sudden death due to cocaine toxicity associated with hypertensive heart disease and cardiomegaly. My decision is based upon my conclusion that the actions of the City of Milwaukee Police Department were not the legal proximate cause of the death of Felix L. Hopgood.
