





This report is being written by P.O. Christopher JACKSON, assigned to District Six, Power Shift.

On Sunday January 18th 2015, at approximately 8:50pm I along with P.O. Kristopher MADUSCHA while assigned to Sq. 6468 responded to a call for service at 2422 S. Howell Av. in the City of Milwaukee. The call referred to a noise nuisance complaint at "The Stone" tavern.

Upon arrival to the location I spoke with the caller Nicki LARSEN. LARSEN stated that she lives across the street from the tavern and that she can feel the bass of the music in her residence. She further stated that when the patients exit the tavern to smoke that the music gets louder. She attempted to contact the tavern by sending a facebook message and calling a number on the taverns website but was unable to get into contact with anyone.

Before entering the tavern P.O. MADUSCHA and myself stayed in our squad car parked across the street from the tavern and monitored the music level. As we waited outside the tavern while doors were closed slight music could be heard, none of which violated the 50 foot noise nuisance ordinance. When officers entered the tavern I spoke with the subject standing behind the bar and serving drinks. That subject was identified as Kristin T. POCHOWSKI F/W 07/12/74 and she stated that she is part owner of the tavern. When I informed her of the loud music complaint she immediately turned the volume down and explained that she is trying to ask the subjects that exit the tavern to smoke to quickly close the door behind them.

POCHOWSKI worked well in wanting to correct the issue to avoid further problems. All the licenses were checked and were up to date. Later at District Six I checked the Lira system and observed a different subject listed as the applicant agent. POCHOWSKI is listed on the same form is listed as the building owner and has a valid bartenders license on file.

A verbal warning for the music complaint was given and the following license premise report was filed regarding this call.

#### PA-33E Narrative

This report is is typed by PO Kristopher MADUSCHA, assigned to District Six, Power Shift, Squad 6468, along with PO Justin JOLLIFF.

On Sunday March 8th 2015, at approximately 8:23 pm, PO JACKSON and I were dispatched to 2422 S. Howell Av. (Stone Tavern) for a loud music complaint. The call referred to a noise nuisance complaint at "The Stone" tavern.

Upon arrival, I positioned the squad car on the eastside of the street in the 2300 block of S. Howell Av with the windows down. I observed 3-5 patrons standing in front of the tavern. I could not hear music coming from the tavern. I then positioned the squad car directly across from the tavern. I entered the tavern and spoke with the bartender/part owner Kristin T. POCHOWSKI (W/F, 7-12-74). I informed Kristin regarding the loud music complaint. Kristin immediately turned the volume down and stated she has a sign on the door for the patrons to close the door quickly after exiting.

Kristin asked if there was anything that can be done to avoid further issues. I advised Kristin about the patrons exiting and entering the tavern closing the door quickly and to keep the voulme down. Kristin wants to correct the problem to avoiding further issues. All the licenses were checked and were up to date. Later at District Six, I checked the Lira system and observed a different subject Shawn T. LEET (W/M, 11-25-72)as the listed owner. Kristin is listed on the same form, as is Shawn, as the owner. Kristin also has a valid bartenders license on file.

PO JOLLIFF spoke with the caller Nichole T. LARSON (W/F, 12-15-81) who stated she lives across the street from the tavern. Nichole stated she hears the bass when patrons exit and enter the tavern after smoking.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

The bartender then called a cab for the patron and when the cab arrived, a couple of patrons assisted the subject to the cab when the subject became combative and struck one of the patrons in the face. The cab driver also attempted to assist but was also struck in the face. The subject then fell hitting his head but refused medical attention. Police cited the subject for assault and battery and disorderly conduct. No tavern violations were observed.

4. On 04/05/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight at 733 West Oklahoma Avenue (Lost Cause). Investigation revealed there was a fight inside the business between at least two female patrons. When these patrons were escorted out of the business by the doorman, a larger fight commenced. #### PA-33E Narrative

This report is being written by Police Officer Christopher JACKSON, assigned to District Six, Power Shift.

On Sunday, April 5, 2015 at approximately I along with P.O. Kristopher MADUSCHA while assigned to Sq. 6468 were dispatched to 733 W. Oklahoma Av. in the City of Milwaukee for a Fight complaint. Other units that assisted on this call were: Sq. 6340, P.O. Tyler PILEGGI, Sq. 6323, P.O. Dale STASZEWSKI, Sq. 6320, P.O. Brian HEDER and Sq. 6311, Sgt. Robert THIEL.

Upon arrival to the location the premise was recognized as the Lost Cause Bar. Outside the tavern several squads interviewed witnesses that stated all the subjects involved in the physical altercation had left the area in unknown directions.

I then entered the tavern and spoke with the on duty bartender Patricia A. LISTON F/W 08/09/62. LISTON stated that as she served customers on one end of the bar she noticed that group began to gather and a commotion began. She then stated that the doorman escorted the subjects outside the tavern. Minutes later LISTON was directed to the window, facing north on to W. Oklahoma Av. by customers claiming a fight was taking place outside the tavern. LISTON observed the fight but could not identify any of the subjects involved. She had no further information regarding.

I then spoke with the on duty manger of the tavern Jacqueline Q. SOMMERFELT F/W 09/23/82. SOMMERFELT had a similar recollection of the incident that took place. She stated once the subjects were escorted out the tavern that they would just leave and did not believe it would escalate to a physical fight. SOMMERFELT informed me that the owner of the tavern was out of town on vacation and probably would not answer any phone calls. I then asked SOMMERFELT as the manager and in charge person of the tavern to make contact with the owner regarding the incident.

When I exited the tavern a gray 4dr SUV pulled up to the location. Exiting the vehicle was a subject identified as Jessica NAVEJAR F/W 06/30/77. NAVEJAR stated that she was at the tavern celebrating a birthday of her 21-year-old daughter. While inside the tavern she states that a w/f that she previously was involved in a physical altercation with entered. She stated to me that she believed the female name to be Magdalia MURILLO and should be approximately 35years old. She states that the two of them watched each and made several faces towards each other. The two then approached each other and a physical altercation began. The doorman then escorted them out of the tavern.

NAVEJAR states that outside the tavern she was jumped by the female and two or three male subjects. She received several scratches to the face and left shoulder. NAVEJAR was also bleeding from here-left pinky finger with broken skin that she stated she received when the female bit her. She stated that when the fight was broken up that she drove home and wiped off her face and cleaned up.

On scene NAVEJAR denied medical attention but stated that she will go to the hospital on her on time. I informed NAVEJAR that I would need to view her discharge paperwork if she visits the hospital regarding on how the report will be filed. I also informed NAVEJAR that I would need time to attempt to identify the f/w involved in this incident and would contact her at 7pm later in the evening.

On 04/05/15 at approximately 7:00pm I called NAVEJAR using the cell phone number she confirm with me. I was unable to reach NAVEJAR to find out if she received any additional medical attention for her injuries. I also called at 8:15pm and left a recorded voicemail on the phone to reach me at the district. The last attempt to contact NAVEJAR was on 04/06/15 at 7:10pm and I once again was unable to make contact.
