Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 070943

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is the Common Council Resolution File Number 070943, granting a special privilege to Living Epistles Church of Holiness for a platform with barrier free access ramp and excess door swing to encroach into the public right-of-way for the premises at 4022 North 27th Street.

The applicant is in the process of remodeling its property at 4022 North 27th Street and is requesting permission to construct and maintain a platform with barrier free access ramp and excess door swing. The platform and ramp will project up to 3 feet 8 inches into the 22-foot wide east sidewalk area of North 27th Street. The platform and ramp structure is to commence at a point approximately 143 feet north of the northline of West Capitol Drive and will extend 18 feet 10 inches to the north.

We are not aware that the presence of said items will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said items to occupy the public right-of-way.
