
The fence will be built of Northern White Cedar in Yutka Fence's Traditional Style. The posts will measure 4" by 4" with a Dog Ear Post Cap. The top rail will measure 1.5" high by 3.5" wide.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 


