5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

Stucco Restoration:

Remove failing stucco and lathe as necessary. Re-install lathe and scratch coat over repaired substrate Bond and mesh hairline cracks where substrate is stable and intact

Brown coat (hand trowel) entire house and garage with a cementitious material base

Spray apply finish layer(s) of cementitious stucco with a color matching as close as possible as the original, texture to be similar to existing.

Exterior Painting of House and Garage

All fascia trim, gables, all soffits, windows, window frames, doors, door frames, cedar shake, front flower box, storms, screens, basement windows/storms, third floor dormers, rear porch railing, & wood surfaces on garage to be prepped and painted

Painting process:

- -Mobilize & prepare site & wood on the exterior of the building for painting.
- -Carefully wash soffits and fascia boards around the house.
- -Remove all loose paint chips on woodwork described above. Replace caulking as needed and fill in deep holes that may exist.
- -Spot prime with oil base primer all bare wood areas created after sanding and scraping
- -Prepare wood doors and storm doors for staining. Sand door surfaces, and clean off residue. Apply stain if necessary and blend color as close as possible. Apply two three final coats of polyurethane. -Apply two coats of paint to wood areas described above.

Window Glazing:

Remove loose glazing on windows as needed and replace with new glazing. Prime glazing prior to painting. Replace glazing that is loose or is falling out only

Replacement or repair of wooden storm windows (11). Replacement to match existing. Repair to blend with existing. Replace/repair as needed cedar shake shingles on both 3rd floor dormers.

Inspect all exterior woodwork. Repair/replace rotted/damaged parts as needed. Includes using architectural restoration epoxies and other filling material. To match existing. Remove, rebuild and re-install garage north person door. To restore to original
