Dear Parents/Guardians:

I am writing to inform you that the King's Academy Board of Directors has decided to return to our roots and once again become a private school. As you may or may not know, when we opened our doors in the fall of 1999, King's Academy was a private Christian School. And, we strongly believe that we can better serve our students by making sure that they are immersed in a learning environment that stresses the power of Jesus Christ in their lives, coupled with a Christ centered curriculum.

In order to facilitate this change we are applying to be re-admitted into the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program **beginning school year 2016-17**. The application is the first of many steps that we will have to take; but we are confident that our application will be approved so we can begin our transition over the summer of **2016**.

Please note that we are still currently a Charter School for this school year, 2015-2016; and that this change will not take place until all aspects of the application process have been approved.

It is our hope that you will consider remaining with us as a Private Christian School next fall (2016); and if you have any questions, members of the Board of Directors will be present at the first Parent Orientation to address any and all concerns.
