The sign proposed is a temporary tent sign, which is brought out during the day and taken in at night. It is not permanently affixed to the building or the grounds. Its size and shape are consistent with others in the city.


Since the sign is movable, it can be placed where there is visibility. The sign will be brought in at night.
