


Community Prosecution



- Evidence-based targeting to complaints interventions and to diminish wasted resources and citizen increase effectiveness of
- » Substantial information sharing among enforcement agencies
- so Scaled enforcement based on severity of nuisances or code violations
- so Coordinated effort for high value target landlords

- Evaluation of existing laws and suggestions to strengthen nuisance abatement mechanisms
- Increased use of RRI
- DNS building code violations as trigger for 80-10
- Lower amount of nuisance calls to trigger 80-10
