| Albany, NY | Yes | Company must have an employee on premise or on call 24/7. | No fee required for release of vehicle if owner is willing to correct the violation and tow truck is not in motion (except \$20 fee between 6 p.m. and 7 a.m.). | License application must include the address of the premises where towed vehicles are to be stored. |
| Indianapolis, IN | Yes | Company must have an employee on premise or on call 24/7 (excluding holidays). Storage fees do not accrue if facility is not open. | No fee required unless 2 tires have been lifted off the ground (drop fee equal to half the regular tow fee). | "All vehicles towed must be stored within the county or within a 15 mile radius of where the tow originated." |
| Long Beach, CA | Yes | Vehicle must be available for release during a minimum period of 4 hours after impounding. | No fee required for release prior to vehicle being removed if owner disputes tow operator's authority to tow. | "All vehicles impounded in the city shall be stored within the city." |
| Orlando, FL | Yes | Personnel must be on call 24/7, including holidays, for release of vehicle. Must release within 1 hour. | Drop fee equal to half the regular tow fee, applicable after a vehicle has been connected to the tow truck. Must allow owner 20 minutes to secure payment. | Vehicles must be stored within a 10-mile radius of the point of removal. |
| Pittsburgh, PA | Yes | Company cannot charge a fee for storage for any day in which the business's lot was not open 4 hours. | No fee if owner arrives prior to vehicle being connected to or loaded onto tow truck. | Licenses issued whether or not businesses are physically headquartered in the city. Business must demonstrate premises is secure. |
| Scottsdale, AZ | No | Personnel must be available 24/7 to release car. | No fee required for release if owner returns before truck enters public street | None. |
| St. Louis, MO | Yes | Business must maintain "24-hour release provision." | None | None. |
| St. Paul, MN | Yes | None. | No fee if owner arrives prior to vehicle being lifted off the ground. | Cannot tow outside city limits, unless location approved by city council. |
| Syracuse, NY | Yes | Company must be open for retrieval of vehicles between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily or whenever providing services, whichever is greater. | No fee if vehicle is not attached. \$20 fee if vehicle is attached and owner arrives before vehicle is removed. | License application must include the address of the premises where towed vehicles are to be stored. |
| Tallahassee, FL | Yes | Business must staff or monitor phones at all times (no pagers). Vehicles can be picked up within one hour of request (provided fees are paid). | No fee if vehicle not connected. If connected but still on property, drop fee is half the regular tow fee (\$44). Must provide reasonable time to obtain payment. | None. |
