Resolution recognizing and congratulating Pastor Victor C. Davis on the occasion of his 60th birthday.

WHEREAS,

PASTOR VICTOR C. DAVIS

celebrated his 60th birthday on September 13, 2015, during a special event at Greater Mount Sinai Church of God In Christ, 5384 N. 60th St.; and

WHEREAS, *Pastor Victor C. Davis was born and reared in Milwaukee, attended Milwaukee Public Schools, graduated from Custer High School and received a scholarship to attend Macalester College in Minnesota, and later attended the University Biblical College in Bethany, Oklahoma; and*

WHEREAS, *In 1988, Pastor Victor C. Davis received his Pastoral appointment after receiving spirit-led directions for the ministry from his father, Rev. Walter Davis, and it was also the year his father asked that the church be renamed to be Greater Mount Sinai Church of God In Christ; and*

WHEREAS, *Under the leadership of Pastor Victor C. Davis, the Greater Mount Sinai membership has increased from 75 members to its present membership of more than 900 members; and*

WHEREAS, *Pastor Victor C. Davis was instrumental in assisting his mother in the establishment of the Myrtle Davis Education Fund ("MDEF"), and as her continued aspirations were to one day provide safe, affordable and comfortable housing for senior citizens, on October 23, 2004, that dream became a reality with a ribbon-cutting celebration and dedication of the Myrtle M. Davis Senior Complex, and on September 9, 2006, to honor his father's legacy, Rev. Davis, along with the Greater Mount Sinai family, celebrated and dedicated the Walter Davis Senior Complex; and*

WHEREAS, *At Greater Mount Sinai, Pastor Victor C. Davis has added an early Sunday morning service, revamped and revitalized the Men's Ministry to promote and encourage the men to become better fathers, husbands and committed men of God, and on December 5, 2011, Rev. Davis humbly accepted and was formally licensed as Superintendent of the New Covenant District in the 3rd Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction of Wisconsin; and*

WHEREAS, *A generous and giving man to those in need, Pastor Victor C. Davis is also a devoted father of two daughters, Donnetta Marie and Shaunae LaToya; one son, Victor Carl, Jr., and three grandchildren, Bliss, Curtis, and Sameer; now, therefore, be it*
