There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The commendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit. Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 12/08/11 at 5:42 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1566 S Muskego Avenue for a Battery complaint. Officers spoke to the owner of the tavern who was the victim, Francisco Gomez-Ortiz who stated he was walking outside of his tavern and was approached by four unknown subjects. These subjects stated "Fuck You Mexican" and Gomez-Ortiz responded, "What are you talking about?". Gomez-Ortiz stated he feared for his safety and turned to knock on the bar window to get the attention of people inside the bar when one of the subjects hit Gomez-Ortiz on his right shoulder and back. Gomez-Ortiz was able to get inside the bar and was able to detain the subject who hit him until police arrived.
- 2. On 03/04/12 at 8:11 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1566 S Muskego for a Battery complaint. Upon police arrival, officers were advised that all parties involved had left, however one subject was pointed out walking northbound down Muskego. Officers caught up with the subject and observed the male to have a swollen eye and small cut above his right eye. The subject was intoxicated and refused medical attention. The subject stated to police that an unknown male hit him for no reason. The subject was uncooperative with police and did not want to press charges. Officers returned to the bar and spoke with the bar owner, Francisco Gomez-Oritz who stated two patrons were arguing and he asked them to leave. Gomez-Ortiz further stated both parties stepped outside and that neither returned.

- 3. On 03/24/13 at 12:05 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1566 S Muskego Avenue for a Property Damage complaint. Police spoke with Francisco Gomez-Ortiz who stated at approximately 11:45 pm, his security escorted a patron out of the bar due to his intoxication/disruptive behavior. A few minutes later, witnesses observed that same patron throw a brick through several vehicles that were parked in front of the bar. Security went outside and restrained the subject until police arrived. The subject was cited.
- 4. On 05/06/13 at 1:00 am, Milwaukee police investigated a Battery that occurred outside of the El Cantarito Bar. Investigation revealed a patron of the bar sustained a cut to his head due to a fight that took place outside of the bar. An argument started inside the bar between two parties and continued outside with argument becoming physical. Video surveillance did capture some of the incident, however, did not capture how the victim sustained his injury. Police spoke with the licensee, Francisco Gomez-Ortiz, who was present during the incident.

5. On 02/15/2014 Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1566 South Muskego Avenue (Cantarito's Bar). A security guard at the business told police that a subject had pointed a handgun at him

while inside the business. Investigation revealed it was a bb gun. Milwaukee police incident report #140460128 filed.

6. On 07/01/2014 Milwaukee police were dispatched to an armed robbery complaint at Cantaritos Bar (1566 South Muskego Avenue). Investigation revealed that a bartender and a security guard from the business were robbed at gunpoint while standing in the front entrance of the bar. One of the suspects was identified by the victims and was later arrested. The suspect during a mirandized interview stated he went to the bar because he knew of a security guard that sold cocaine at the location. The security guard was identified by the suspect as Gustavo TORRES. The suspect stated that when he was exchanging money with the security guard for drugs, two subjects approached them and robbed them at gunpoint. Milwaukee police incident report #141820003 filed.

- 7. On 08/17/2014 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shooting at 1726 West Arrow Street. Investigation revealed the victim had been a patron at Cantaros Tavern (1566 South Muskego Avenue) earlier and had gone outside of the bar to help a friend of his that was being beaten. The victim was shot while intervening. The establishment was cooperative and provided video of the incident. Milwaukee police incident report #142290002 filed.
- 8. On 10/06/2014, at 8:22pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1566 South Muskego Avenue to determine if the business was the scene of a battery/cutting that was being investigated at St. Luke's hospital. The bartender who started her shift at 4pm, stated during her shift an altercation occurred at the business between several men. During the altercation one individual was struck with a bottle. She was able to break up the fight and the individuals left the bar. Milwaukee police incident report #142790169 filed.
- 9. On 11/01/2014 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a subject with a weapon complaint at 1566 West Muskego Avenue. Investigation revealed a security guard was struck in the back of the head with a glass bottle, resulting in an injury that required stitches. Milwaukee police incident report #143050149 filed.

10. On 12/28/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1566 South Muskego Avenue (Cantaritos Bar) to determine if the business had implemented improvements previously expressed to Officer Vodicka during a meeting on 10/21/2014. During this check, officers did not observe metal detectors being used. Additionally, officers did not observe any signs indicating that weapons were not allowed, that loitering was not allowed and that the premise was under 24 hour surveillance. The officer was approached by a security guard named "Jason" who told him that the applicant would bend the rules allowing patrons into the bar without identification, that he would not enforce the dress code for certain patrons, and that he allowed under age people into the bar. Officers did not observe any violations.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by P.O. Bradley JOHNSON, assigned to District 2, later power. On 10-28-14 at approximately 2:30am, I received notification to conduct this licensed person/premises report regarding an armed robbery incident that occurred at the Cantaritos Bar on 06-30-14 (Inc #14-182-0003).

On Monday, July 1, 2014, at approximately 12:33am, while on Sq 2451 with P.O. Gerardo OROZCO, we were dispatched to this robbery which occurred on 06-30-14 at approximatley 11:49pm. Upon arrival we spoke with the victim, Gustavo TORRES, M/W, 07-30-69, and the bartender, Silveria CRUZ-VERGARA, F/W, 09-20-76. Both were outside in the front entranceway smoking cigarettes, when three subjects approached. Two were wearing masks, and one put a a gun to TORRES and demanded his money. The subjects went inside TORRES's pockets and stole his wallet and keys and fled from the establishment. The subject who was not wearing the mask was recognized by TORRES and CRUZ-VERGARA as a patron of the establishment known as "Pollo." I then contacted the owner, Francisco GOMEZ-ORTIZ, M/W, 06-21-71, who lived in apartment #4 of that building and informed him of the incident and recovered video footage.

It should be noted, "Pollo" was identified as Reymundo CORONADO, M/H, 03-14-88 and positively identified in a photo array as one of the actors in the armed robbery. On Wed, 07-02-14, at approximately 8:12pm, CORONADO was arrested regarding and conveyed to District 2 where P.O. Patrick COE conducted a mirandized interview regarding. During the interview, CORONADO stated he was arrested regarding an armed robbery. He initially informed P.O. COE that he went to 1566 W. Muskego Av., "Cantaritos Bar" because he knows the security guard, Gustavo TORRES, (W/M, 07-30-69) sells cocaine out of the bar. P.O. COE showed CORONADO a booking photo of TORRES and he positively identified him as he knows him from frequently buying illegal narcotics from him. CORONADO stated he walked up to the bar where he met the bartender smoking a cigarette. He stated she asked him if he wanted TORRES and he told her yes. The bartender walked inside to ask TORRES to come out. CORONADO briefly spoke with TORRES and he stated he realized that he forgot his money "in the car." So he left TORRES outside of the bar and walked away to see if he left his money in "the car." CORONADO then walked back to the front of the bar where TORRESS was standing and began to exchange the money for the narcotics, when two individuals approached him pointing a gun at TORRES and robbed him of his property.

End of investigation.

PA-33E Narrative

This report was written by P.O. Jose RIVERA assigned to District 2, Squad 2331, Late Shift.

On Sunday, August 17th, 2014 at 12:06a I responded to 1726 W. Arrow St. for a shooting. See IR# 14-229-0015.

Upon arrival I was flagged down by (Helen S. LORANCA, H/F, 04/12/93) who stated her boyfriend had been shot. I then observed a Hispanic male later identified as (Francisco J. PARRA-ALVAREZ, H/M, 09/16/76) lying on his back in front of 1737 W. Arrow St. in the grass between the sidewalk and curb.

I then observed what appeared to be a gunshot wound on the left side of his stomach near his waist.

Shortly later Milwaukee Fire Department arrived and PARRA-ALVAREZ was conveyed to Froedtert Hospital for medical treatment by Lieutenant HAMBURGER of MED 14. Also on scene was Lieutenant PIPPIN of Engine 31 green shift.

Detective Tony J CASTRO assigned to North Investigations Division, Squad 9334, Late Power Shift responded to this location and took over the investigation.

It was later determined the victim of the shooting (Francisco J. PARRA-ALVAREZ) was inside Cantaros Tavern located at 1566 S Muskego Ave and heard his friend (Oscar E HERRERA, h/m, 10/26/1974) was outside the tavern getting beat up and came out to intervene and was shot.

Bar owner, Francisco GOMEZ-ORTIZ (W/M 06/21/71) was cooperative on scene and provided police with video of the incident. No violations were observed at the tavern.

NARRATIVE SECTION:

This report is written by P.O. Manuel LUCENA-MARTINEZ, assigned to District Two, Early Shift.

On Monday, October 6 2014, at approximately 8:22pm, while assigned to Squad 2241, P.O. Luis VARGAS-RAMOS and I were dispatched to 1566 S Muskego Av to look for a possible battery cutting scene, which squad 2221 (P.O. Kevin Panfil and P.O. Waseem SAROSH) were investigating at St. Lukes Hospital.

Upon arrival, P.O. VARGAS-RAMOS and I observed a blood trail leading from the front door of the establishment to the north side of the building. Once the scene was secured, we entered the bar and spoke with the on-duty bartender who was identified as, Eulogio SILVA-CARMONA (w/f 01/21/79) who resides at 1500A W Mitchell St, phone # 736-7046. Class D operators license # BART-0207809. SILVA-CARMONA stated that she arrived at 8pm and heard patrons talking of some sort of altercation, which had occurred prior to her arriving. SILVA-CARMONA stated that she did not see or hear any specifics of the altercation. The owner, who was identified as Francisco GOMEZ-ORTIZ (w/m 06/21/71), arrived on scene after being called by P.O VARGAS-RAMOS. GOMEZ-ORTIZ was asked to view video regarding the incident, which had occurred in his establishment, GOMEZ-ORTIZ was initially very hesitant to show officers the video of the bar. GOMEZ-ORTIZ made multiple inquiries regarding the details of the incident before letting officer's view the video. The bartender, who was on-duty at the time of the incident, arrived on scene and was identified as Maria Del Refugio RAMIREZ OCAMPO (w/f 06/06/72) Class D operators license #BART-204911. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that she started at 4pm. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that during her shift there was an altercation with a group of males near the pool table inside of the bar. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that she observed the males engage in a physical altercation at which point somebody was struck with a glass beer bottle. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that she was able to break up the altercation and had both parties left the establishment using separate exits. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that once both parties had exited, she began to clean up glass shards from the altercation.

It should be noted that nobody from the establishment had called Police, and the victim called 911 once at the Hospital. For a detailed report, please refer to IR# 14-279-0169. It should also be noted that this establishment is known not to cooperate with Police investigations. Prior incidents that have stemmed from the establishment are as follow: Shooting occurred on 08/17/14, refer to IR #'s 14-229-0002 and 14-229-0015. A fight, which occurred on 08/18/14, refer to CAD # 14-230-3067.

NARRATIVE SECTION:

This report is written by P.O. Manuel LUCENA-MARTINEZ, assigned to District Two, Early Shift.

On Monday, October 6 2014, at approximately 8:22pm, while assigned to Squad 2241, P.O. Luis VARGAS-RAMOS and I were dispatched to 1566 S Muskego Av to look for a possible battery cutting scene, which squad 2221 (P.O. Kevin Panfil and P.O. Waseem SAROSH) were investigating at St. Lukes Hospital.

Upon arrival, P.O. VARGAS-RAMOS and I observed a blood trail leading from the front door of the establishment to the north side of the building. Once the scene was secured, we entered the bar and spoke with the on-duty bartender who was identified as, Eulogio SILVA-CARMONA (w/f 01/21/79) who resides at 1500A W Mitchell St, phone # 736-7046. Class D operators license # BART-0207809. SILVA-CARMONA stated that she arrived at 8pm and heard patrons talking of some sort of altercation, which had occurred prior to her arriving. SILVA-CARMONA stated that she did not see or hear any specifics of the altercation. The owner, who was identified as Francisco GOMEZ-ORTIZ (w/m 06/21/71), arrived on scene after being called by P.O VARGAS-RAMOS. GOMEZ-ORTIZ was asked to view video regarding the incident, which had occurred in his establishment, GOMEZ-ORTIZ was initially very hesitant to show officers the video of the bar. GOMEZ-ORTIZ made multiple inquiries regarding the details of the incident before letting officer's view the video. The bartender, who was on-duty at the time of the incident, arrived on scene and was identified as Maria Del Refugio RAMIREZ OCAMPO (w/f 06/06/72) Class D operators license #BART-204911. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that she started at 4pm. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that during her shift there was an altercation with a group of males near the pool table inside of the bar. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that she observed the males engage in a physical altercation at which point somebody was struck with a glass beer bottle. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that she was able to break up the altercation and had both parties left the establishment using separate exits. RAMIREZ OCAMPO stated that once both parties had exited, she began to clean up glass shards from the altercation.

It should be noted that nobody from the establishment had called Police, and the victim called 911 once at the Hospital. For a detailed report, please refer to IR# 14-279-0169. It should also be noted that this establishment is known not to cooperate with Police investigations. On Sunday, 12-28-14, at approximately 8:37pm, Squad 2479 (PO MARTINEZ, PO CARTAGENA, and PO WARD) conducted a License Premise Check at 1566 S Muskego Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53204 (Cantaritos Bar). The primary focus of this check was to see if the proposed improvements stated by Francisco GOMEZ ORTIZ in a meeting with PO VODICKA on October 21st, 2014 were implemented or not.

Upon arrival, I (PO MARTINEZ) did not observe any metal detectors being used by security to check patrons before they entered the bar. I also did not observe any visible signs regarding, no weapons being allowed, no loitering, or premises under 24 hour surveillance. While on scene, I was approached by Jason, a security guard at the bar, who stated he has observed GOMEZ ORTIZ bend the rules for certain people who come to his bar. Jason stated GOMEZ ORTIZ would allow patrons to enter the bar without identification. GOMEZ ORTIZ would let the dress code slide with certain patrons. One last observation Jason mentioned was GOMEZ ORTIZ was allowing under age people to enter his bar.

I was not able to observe some of the implemented changes on GOMEZ ORTIZ's list because it entailed additional training for employees, making contact with sorrounding neighbors, and attending crime prevention meetings.

During the remainder of the tavern check, Officers did not observe any violations and the staff was cooperative with police.



- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.





- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
