There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. I OBSERVED THE KNOWN SUBJECT, (LEOTIS HYCH) DRIVING AWAY FROM HIS "CAR WASH" LOCATED ON THE N/W CORNER OF 55TH AND LISBON AVE., HIS PICK-UP TRUCK FLATBED WAS FILLED WITH TIRES. I DID NOT SEE ANY JUNK COLLECTOR VEHICLE SIGNAGE ON THE TRUCK, A TRAFFIC STOP WAS ENGAGED AFTER THE HYCH PULLED OVER TO ADJUST HIS LOAD OF TIRES. I STOPPED AND ASKED MR. HYCH WHERE WAS HE GOING WITH THOSE TIRES? HYCH REPLIED, I'M GOING TO GET RID OF THEM AT THE TIRE SHOP ON TEUTONIA AVE. I ASKED IF HE HAS A TIRE LICENSE? HYCH REPIED THAT HE DOESN'T NEED ONE BECAUSE HE IS JUST GETTING RID OF THEM, GIVING THEM AWAY TO A FRIEND.

SEATED IN THE FRONT PASSENGER SEAT WAS DONNIE RAY RICKS, B/M 08-29-1952. I FOLLOWED THEM TO BEST TIRE CENTER LOCATED AT 4979 N. TEUTONIA AVE., (P) 445-2378.

I SPOKE WITH THE MANAGER OF BEST TIRES, A WILLIAM F. SUTTON, B/M 01-15-1956, (P) 477-6424. MR. SUTTON DID NOT CONFIRM NOR DENY THAT HE PAYS MR. HYCH FOR THE TIRES HE RECIEVES FROM HYCH ON THIS DATE AND TIME.

I DID A ROUGH COUNT OF THE TIRES UNLOADED BY HYCH. THERE WERE ABOUT 37 TIRES HYCH BROUGHT TO BEST TIRES.

I ADVISED BOTH HYCH AND RICKS THAT THEY WERE GOING TO BE CITED AT POLICE STATION # 3 FOR NOT HAVING JUNK COLLECTOR, NOR TIRE LICENSES, THEY WOULD THEN BE RELEASED WITH FUTURE COURT DATES. BOTH COOPERATED WITH THAT DIRECTIVE.

ON WEDNESDAY 02-11-2015 AT ABOUT 1:20 PM, I STOPPED BY BEST TIRES CENTER AND AGAIN SPOKE WITH THE MANAGER, MR. SUTTON. SUTTON ADMITTED THAT HE DOES INDEED BUY TIRES FROM LEOTIS HYCH. HE HAS BEEN BUYING TIRES FROM HYCH FOR ABOUT 3 TO 4 MONTHS NOW. SUTTON SAID THAT HE DIDN'T WANT TO SAY ANYTHING TO ME THE OTHER DAY BECAUSE LEOTIS HYCH WAS STANDING RIGHT THERE LISTENING.

This report was written by P.O. Brian LaROQUE, assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift. On 3/20/15 I responded to 6315 W Fond Du Lac Av (Gene Lane & Lounge) for a Battery Cutting. Upon my arrival I learned that the victim of the cutting had been pronounced dead on the scene and that this was now a homicide investigation. I arrived at the location to work with the employees and gather information for a tavern report. During my time at the location the employees cooperated with the investigation and provided us access to their camera system.

This is an ongoing investigation and for further information regarding please refer to the police reports. It should be noted that it is unclear where the victim was when the cutting occurred but it is clear that he did not gain entry into the tavern prior to the incident.

I spoke with Eugene SMITH regarding the incident and the age restriction at the tavern. SMITH informed me that he was not aware that he has an age restriction.

Phase 1 Observations outside the location

VEHICLES:

Vehicles were legally parked in the parking lot of the business and on both the north and south side of W Fond Du Lac Av.

CITIZENS:

There is an outside patio section at the bar, which is gated in. Upon review of the camera system you could see that there were small groups of people outside of the tavern throughout the night.
