**Description of work** Until some future date when the applicant will be able to restore the exterior of the building, he is making repairs that will include work on the north (front) and west (side) elevations.

Work on the north/front elevation will include: removal of loose glass and replacing select wooden frames with new wooden ones to match installing new aluminum storms to match existing ones removing crumbling material at the junction of the concrete and the artificial stone installing and painting new plywood around front entry

Work on the west/side elevation will include:
repainting of windows
repainting door
replacing glass block windows
replacing select wood windows with new wood windows to match
installing metal handrails at southernmost entrance door


All work will be carried out as described.



New aluminum storms to match west elevation (#23 - #26)

New plywood installed and painted (#27)

Repair crumbling material (#28)



New wood windows to match existing (#17,#18,#19) Repair any broken window panes. Paint windows (#7, #8) and door (#21). Replace glass block in basement openings. Add railings to steps at door.
