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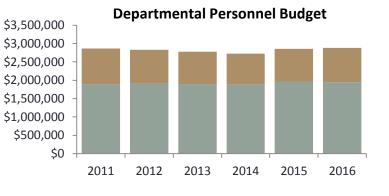
The number of staff members that are eligible for retirement in 2016.

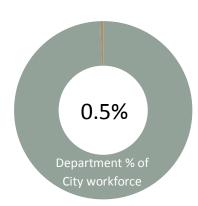

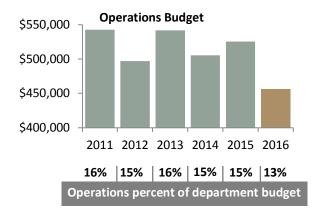

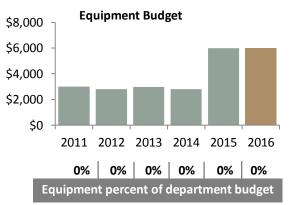
Revenue

Changes in the department's revenue accounts include the following:

- Charges for Services \$ 1,514,000
 13.6% decrease from 2015
- Forfeitures \$4,060,000
 9.9% decrease from 2015

Grants

This department receives no grant funding.



Special Purpose Accounts

The department is not proposing any funds in the 2016 Budget for SPA accounts Clerk of Court/Witness Fee Fund and Driver's License Recovery and Employability Program. However, funds are proposed in the following SPA account:

• Municipal Court Intervention Program \$425,000

Capital Requests

There is no new funding proposed in the 2016 Proposed Budget. The current capital project, CATS and Website Upgrade, is an ongoing project.

Amount of funds requested for General Office Expense, a 24% decrease from 2015.

\$26,500

Total amount proposed for Other Operating Services. Mandatory witness fees were removed from the SPA account and transferred to this line item.

10,232 The number of driver's license suspensions lifted by the Court in 2014.

2,809

The number of building & zoning cases that have been filed with the Court as of September, 2015. The cases are down from 3,289 as of September, 2014.

Court Appearances

In 2014, the department's court appearances total was 93,278.

YTD through September 2015, court appearances are 62,046 (projected year-end total of 89,000).

The court appearance projection for 2016 is based on the current year's first quarter's total appearances.

Electronic Case Filing Jacket Update

The Electronic Case Filing Jacket continues to provide savings for the department. In addition to eliminating the vacant Court Assistant II position and the Court Assistant III position not being funded in 2016, the projected return on investment for the Electronic Case Filing Jacket is about \$726,000.

Night Court

In 2014, the Court held 25 night court sessions on 9 dates. With 362 individuals scheduled, 258 appeared in court.

For 2015, the Court held 24 night court sessions on 12 dates. Through September, 244 individuals were scheduled and 191 appeared in court.

Based on the number of individuals appearing at the night court sessions, the only notable issue recognized by the Court is that the public is not taking advantage of utilizing night court services.
