










**Departmental Budget Appropriation Category** 



# **Budget per Capita**







Change in department FTE positions resulting from conversion of a half-time Office Assistant III position to a full-time position.

# **Staffing Update**

One Office Assistant III position is changed from half-time in 2015 to full-time under the 2016 Proposed Budget. This change stems from increased workload related to the new BOZA Periodic Property Inspection Program (CC File No. 140873).

### **Staffing Update**

While the Board of Zoning Appeals has 11 authorized positions, 7 are actually Board members, not O&M-funded regular City staff.




