5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.



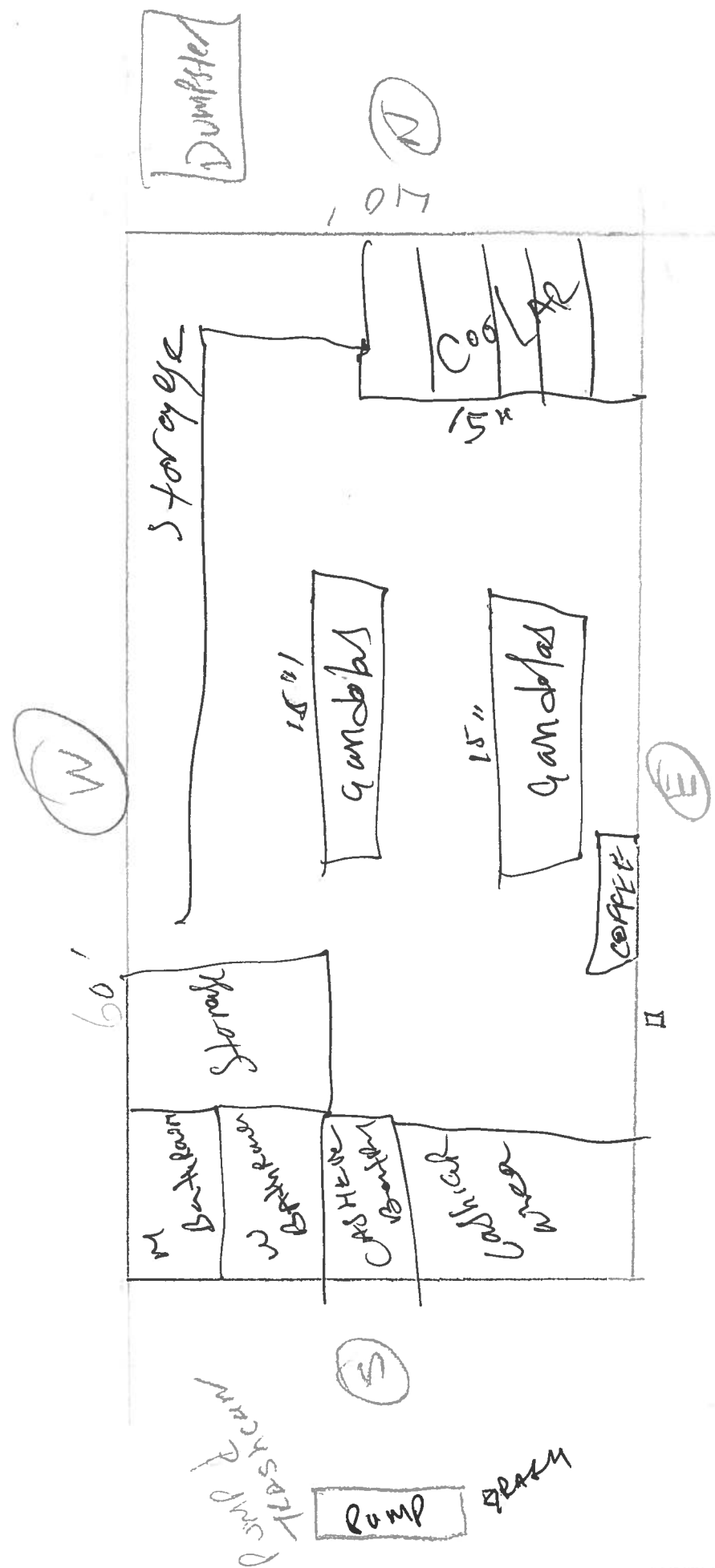

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 04/03/2013 the applicant met with Captain Victor Beecher, Lieutenant Joseph Seitz and Lieutenant Shannon M. Seymer-Tabaska of the Milwaukee police department at the applicant's request. Also in attendance were Obiora Obi, described during the meeting as 75% owner and General Manager, and Sheena Tally, described during the meeting as manager. The applicant was described during the meeting as a 0% owner. During this meeting, some of the potential problems related to a business holding a Class B Tavern license in general and the applicant's ability to handle those potential problems was discussed. The applicant told police he wanted to work collaboratively and cooperatively with police and believed many of the problems that may occur at the business could be handled by security. The applicant informed police that he would be responsible for executive decisions and administration of the business.

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2. On 08/04/2014 the applicant, along with Obiora Obi and a representative from Lucas security, met with Captain Beecher and Sergeant Donovan-Agnew of the Milwaukee police department at Milwaukee police district #4 regarding the re-opening of Onyx. Several changes were outlined by the applicant and Obi that they hoped would help them better operate the establishment. The applicant and Obi stated they are looking forward to working with the department and operating a successful business.

3. On 08/15/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at Onyx Night Club. Obiora Obi identified himself as the Manager/Owner of the property and told officers he has hired a new security contractor, that the business will not allow anyone under the age of 25 into the club and that the business will close at 1:30am or 1:45am depending on the size of the crowd. Obi requested Milwaukee police squads be in the area at closing time.

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4. On 04/25/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a theft complaint that occurred at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). Investigation revealed two patrons of the business placed their wallets on a table while they had their pictures taken in a booth. When they went to retrieve their wallets, they discovered both were gone. Obiora Obi and bar security were very cooperative with police during this investigation which led to the suspect being identified and cited.
5. On 05/29/2015 Milwaukee police conducted follow up at Onyx Night Club (3120 West Villard Avenue) regarding an arson investigation. Obiora Obi told officers he received a phone call from a Milwaukee police officer around 5:00am 05/28/2015 advising him of an attempt arson at his business. Obi viewed video footage of the incident and discovered an unknown person pouring gasoline around the exterior of the building, then lighting it with a match or lighter. Milwaukee police incident report #151480019 filed.
6. On 06/02/2015 the applicant, as well as Obiora Obi, met with Milwaukee police at Milwaukee police district #4 regarding an event planned for Onyx Night Club on 06/22/2015. The business will be hosting an event on that date featuring "Lil Wayne". A discussion was held regarding a plan for the staging of this event. Mr. Obi stated he would provide the police with a written copy of the plan.
7. On 06/27/2015 Milwaukee police, along with agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). During this inspection, officers observed no violations of municipal ordinance. However, agents discovered 37 contaminated bottles that were disposed of at the location.

Villard Ave in the City and County of Milwaukee to Investigate a Theft Complaint. Upon arrival I observed that the tavern was closed and that it was after business hours.

P.O. Miller and I were dispatched to District 4 a short time late regarding the Theft complaint that took place at the Onyx. I spoke with Jasmine J. Lanier b/f 1-26-88 who stated that she was at the Onyx Night club and that around 1:30 AM she and her friend Shalonda S. Davis –Low b/f 11-21-86 were in the back of the bar by the

picture booth when they both laid their wallets on the table directly across from the picture booth to take a picture. Lainer stated that when she and Davis-Low returned to the table they noticed that their wallets were missing. Lainer stated that she spoke with Security who stated that they observed a b/f pick the wallets up from off the table and put them in her purse. Lainer stated that the security guard was able to provide her with the video and ID of the person who is responsible for taking and carrying away her belongings.

Lainer also stated that the security guard was able to identify the female by the card reader that is used any time a person enters the premises. Lainer was able to provide me with a picture of the subject and a copy of her driver's license that was giving to her by security.

Obi stated that he immediately contacted the police regarding but by the time police arrived on scene the tavern was closed and the reporting patrons were no longer on scene.

Obi who was very cooperative and was able to provide me with the video showing the suspect who was later identified as Curita D. Cotton b/f 10-24-77 who resides at 711 E. Wright St. Milwaukee WI, 53212 (414 374-9225) who picked up two wallets from off the table located near the picture booth, place them in her wallet, and then walked away. Obi advised me of a card reader that is also used anytime a patron enters his establishment. The card reader was also used to identify Cotton.

On Tuesday June 2nd, 2015 at 8:40am, Jerrel Jones, Obiora Obi, Mr. Lucas (security), myself, P.O. Carrie Resnick and LT. Mark Wroblewski attended a meeting in regards to an upcoming event that will be held at the Onyx Night Club. This meeting took place at District Four, in the Captain's office.

Mr. Obi stated on June 22, 2015, "Lil Wayne" (Well known rapper) will be performing live at this facility. Mr. Obi stated he was requesting District Four to provide Officers to conduct traffic control. I advised Mr. Obi to contact OMAP to hire off duty officers for this event. I had provided this information to him via email in late May. He stated he was waiting to send in his application until after our meeting.

LT. Wroblewski asked Mr. Obi and Mr. Jones if they had a written plan for this event and both stated no, but will provide one before the event. We discussed his plan in person and below is what they will have in place.

Doors will open at 8pm. If the line becomes to long they will open the doors at 7p. This event is first come first serve. There will be no tickets sold prior to this event, except for VIP members. The cost per ticket is \$75.00 (cash only). They are asking for the age requirements to be lowered to the age of 21 without advertisement. The current age limit is 23 years of age. They are also asking for full capicity (675), the current capicity is 500. They will be using a tally counter to keep track of the patrons entering the establishment. It was suggested by LT. Wroblewski, due to the amount of cash that could come into the establishment during this event, when money is being moved throughout the night, that an armed guard walk with the employee that will be dropping money into the safe, as well as guard the door when no one is present in the office area.

Mr. Obi stated "Lil Wayne" will have two tour buses which will be parked on his gated lot. "Lil Wayne" will have approximetly 30 individuals with him during the event. The Onyx will have eight armed uniformed guards on the exterior and 25 unarmed plain clothes security personnel on the interior. Security will be stationed at the front door conducting ID checks, wandng everyone, male and female patdowns, and purse checks. No weapons are allowed on the inside. He stated if they have reached their capicity, the crowd on the exterior will be monitored by security outside, and if they need to, they will tell the crowd they need to leave. If there is an incident on the interior or exterior in the front of the building. Mr. Obi stated they have an exit plan through the two rear doors of the building.

Customers will be able to park their vehicles in the Food Town parking lot after 9pm and the CVS lot after 10pm, otherwise they will be parking in the neighborhood.

Mr. Obi stated this will be advertised on social media only. I later received an email from Obi stating this event will be advertised on the radio as well. I also advised Obi to notify the neighborhood and he stated he was going to go door to door passing out flyers to the neighborhood. I advised him that I would be notifing the Block watch in the area as well.

Mr. Obi stated he would provide a written plan for this event as well. It was suggested, that he have one for each event in the future. He agreed as well.



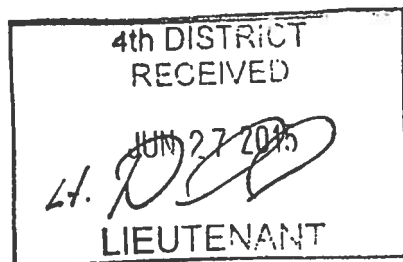
