- WHEREAS, Dr. Arturo Martinez filed a lawsuit was successful in getting a court order to temporarily block the Wisconsin Voter ID law from being implemented during the November 2014 Wisconsin elections; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Arturo Martinez has worked diligently to increase the number of college scholarships to Hispanic students in Milwaukee and increase the number of LULAC chapters in Wisconsin, and has successfully created the Carlos Gomez/LULAC Council 333 Scholarship Fund to become the first chapter in Milwaukee's history to form a partnership with a professional baseball player; and
