File Number 080265 is a resolution dissolving Tax Incremental District No. 14 (Historic King Place) and authorizing the distribution of excess incremental revenue to overlying taxing districts.

Background

- 1. The City of Milwaukee created Tax Incremental District No. 14 (Historic King Place) on July 10, 1990.
- 2. Under the project plan for this District, tax incremental financing was used to provide a loan to assist a developer in converting the former Home Bank Building and annex at the intersection of King Drive and Garfield Avenue into 41 apartments for low- and moderate-income households and 14,000 square feet of ground-floor office and commercial space.
- 3. The net project cost for TID No. 14 (i.e., the amount to be recovered through tax incremental revenues) was \$500,197.

Discussion

- 1. Total tax increments levied through December 31, 2007, were \$604,807.
- 2. Since total tax increments levied for TID No. 14 exceed net project costs for the District, the District can now be dissolved.
- 3. This resolution dissolves TID No. 14 and authorizes the distribution of excess incremental revenue to the overlying taxing districts.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. This resolution authorizes the distribution of an estimated \$104,610 to the overlying taxing districts, which include the City, Milwaukee County, Milwaukee Public Schools, Milwaukee Area Technical College and Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage Districts.
- 2. The City's share of this distribution will be approximately \$37,000.

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
