Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 120918, being a resolution to grant a special privilege to First MKD LLC to construct and maintain a covered walk, cigarette butt disposal container, valet stand, curb ramp, private light fixtures, moveable planters, garbage container, and covered walk in the public right-of-way and to keep and maintain historic building encroachments for the premises 611 North Broadway.

The applicant renovated the historic building at the subject premises into a hotel. As part of the project, the applicant is requesting permission to construct and maintain a covered walk and private light fixtures in the public right-of-way. A site visit also revealed the presence of several other items in the public right-of-way including historic building encroachments, valet stand, garbage can, cigarette disposal bin, curb ramp, and moveable planters.
