Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 04/25/2004 at 2:05 AM officers responded to the licensed premises at 3250 N 2nd St regarding a shooting. Investigation revealed that a fatal shooting occurred outside the tayern at about 2:00 AM and that the victim had been a patron of the tavern. No further information. Incident Report Filed.
- 2. On Wednesday 08/17/2004 at 2:50 AM officers observed patrons exiting the licensed premises at 3250 N 2nd St, the Glass Slipper. Officers then made a lawful inspection of the licensed premises at found 22 patrons still in the tavern. The bartender on duty stated that the patrons were from a birthday party. The applicant was not on the scene and was cited.

- 3. On 02/06/10, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3250 N 2nd Street for a Drug Dealing complaint. Officers spoke with the bartender Nicole Spillers who stated earlier in the evening a female entered the tavern and wanted her boyfriend to leave the tavern. The female was asked to leave and when she did, broke the glass on the front door. Spillers believed that the female was the one who made the call regarding the drug dealing complaint. A check of the tavern found no evidence of drug dealing. No tavern violations were observed.
- 4. On 03/12/10 at 12:18 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2nd and Concordia for a Shots Fired complaint. Investigation found two subjects were arguing in front of the tavern when one actor pulled out a gun and started firing shots at the other subject. Officers were able to view video surveillance that was provided by the tavern owner Jimmy Jordan, which showed the incident. The tape however was in black and white and was blurry. The time on the video also didn't correspond with the actual time of the incident taking place. Casings were found in front of the tavern and were placed on police inventory. Area hospitals were checked for a shooting victim but none were found. Officers also spoke with the bartender Nicole Spillers who stated she heard shots but did not know was shooting outside. Officers also spoke with the doorman John Wright who stated he heard about 16 shots being fired and when he looked outside, did not observe who was shooting the gun.
- 5. On 05/26/13, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Shooting at 3250 N 2nd Street. Investigation revealed that two victims of the shooting had been previously inside the bar. One victim was the DJ who had been performing at the bar, with the second victim being a friend of the DJ, who was a patron. Both subjects had exited the bar to have a cigarette and while outside, were approached by 2-3 males who were armed with guns. The suspects ordered the victims, as well as several other patrons who were outside smoking, to the ground and began going through their pockets. Prior to leaving and possibly before the searching of the pockets, the suspects shot each of the victims once to their right leg. The suspects fled after obtaining money and property from the victims. It is possible that the suspects may have been in the bar previous to the robbery/shooting. The bar's surveillance video depicts not only the lead up to the incident, but what the owner said was the possible two suspects.

6. On 02/15/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 3250 North 2nd Street. Officers discovered patrons inside the business who had not yet attained the legal drinking age of 21 as well as a subject who was armed with a handgun. Milwaukee police incident report #150460010 filed.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is submitted by P.O. Chauncey Harris assigned to District 5 Late Power Shift. On Sunday, 2-15-15 at 1:40am, myself and P.O. Casey Donahue conducted a tavern check at 3250 N. 2nd Street. I observed several patrons outside the location, and it appeared some were under the age of 21 Years and stated they were going into the bar. Upon speaking with the licensee/owner Jimmy D. JORDAN he stated he was unaware of any underage patrons inside the bar. I was alerted by P.O. DONAHUE, that he located a firearm in the men's restroom inside the toilet water tank. A suspect was observed in the restroom and had fled from officers and was later located and arrested. JORDAN stated he is overwhelmed and had not conducted proper checks for weapons or identifications. It was later confirmed the suspect who fled from officers was observed inside the bar on surveillance cameras. We confirmed he had not yet reached the age of 21. I observed two other females in the location who had not shown their picture ID cards to JORDAN. Refer to MPD IR# 15-046-0010

- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

He identified himself as Walayat NAWAB (i/m) 1-5-68, he stated he was working behind the purchase counter at about 10:00 p.m. when three blackmales entered the front entrance door, he observed suspect one point a long barrel rifle at him, suspect two stood at the entrance door keeping him from closing the locking security gate, while suspect three ran around the store gathering items from the shelves. He stated once suspect three obtained several food items they all exited the front door together and fled in a unknown direction. NAWAB thinks these same subjects have come in his store in the past an taken items. I checked the call system and NAWAB called for police service on 1-7-14 MPD cad call# 14-007-2941) at about 12:29 am, stating two blackmale subjects are stealing items from his store. In the past there has been similar incidents of this nature during late hours. There is a extended hours license # 0197174, cigarette/tobacco license # 1022805, and filling station license # 139513. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:


