A review of the intersection of West Hope Avenue and North 62<sup>nd</sup> Street has revealed the need to change the present yield control to a stop control, based on crash data received from the Milwaukee Police Department, which indicates an increase in accidents at this intersection.

We therefore, in the interest of public safety, recommend the installation of the above-captioned traffic control.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
