Notes Experiorures reflect operating costs. Nevertues reflect actual revenue collections. In the 15 years since the Common Council established the snow and ice control charge in 2002, operating expenditures have averaged approximately \$7.8 million per year, while revenues from the fee have averaged just under \$5.2 million/year. The total actual cost recovery rate over the past 13 years is 66%. Two of the five highest years for snow and ice expenditures since 1995 have occurred during the last four years.
