In 2015, under the STRONG Neighborhoods Plan, the Neighborhood Improvement Development Corporation (NIDC) completed the following:

- **Community Outreach Events:** NIDC staff attended 45 events promoting STRONG Neighborhoods Plan programs.
- STRONG Homes Loans
 91 loans approved/closed
 \$1,210,931 of city investment
 18 applications in underwriting/scope writing/contractor bidding process
- Homebuyer Assistance Program (SNP-HBA)
 - 12 loans approved/closed
 \$220,500 of city investment (leveraged additional \$451,334 of investment)
 8 applications in process
 13 prequalifications in process
- Rental Rehabilitation Expansion Program (SNP-RR)

 21 units (approved/closed)
 \$297,922 of city investment (leveraged additional \$490,602 of investment)
 25 units (applications in process)
