Re: Report of the Licenses Committee on the complaint seeking revocation of the Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses held by J. Jesus Gamez for the premises located at 1905 South 6th Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Palomas Place").

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. J. Jesus Gamez (hereinafter the "License") is the holder of Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses for the premises located at 1905 South 6th Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Palomas Place").
- 2. A complaint for revocation of this license was filed with the City Clerk by Captain Heather Wurth on behalf of Chief of Police Edward Flynn. The complaint alleged that the premises known as "Palomas Place" facilitates illegal drug activity and that it constitutes a public nuisance.
- 3. Said summons commanded the appearance of J. Jesus Gamez to answer the complaint for revocation of the Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses on January 5, 2016 at 3:30 p.m. in Room 301-B of City Hall. At that date time and place, the licensee, J. Jesus Gamez failed to appear and answer the complaint as summoned and was not represented by counsel.
- 4. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee found the following:

The Licensee failed to appear.

Assistant City Attorney Nick DeSiato stated there were eight undercover drug buys. Five of the buys occurred between January and May resulting in the purchase of cocaine. A search warrant was executed after the fifth buy when a considerable amount of cocaine and methamphetamine was recovered.

The following day the police were notified that more drugs were being sold. Three more buys took place and another search warrant was executed on October 1st where cocaine was found throughout the premises. The buys were conducted by a confidential informant and a police officer. Every buy was confirmed and tested positive for cocaine or methamphetamine. The Department of Revenue participated in the search warrants, found violations of excise laws and



confiscated three crates of alcohol (the first time) and ninety-nine bottles the second time.

The following individuals were present:

Captain Heather Wurth, Milwaukee Police Department Sergeant Tabiadon, Milwaukee Police Department Police Officer Bill Esqueda, Milwaukee Police Department State Patrol Officer Derek Bergum Agent Georgeann King, Department of Revenue

Alderman Jose Perez stated he is in support of the revocation.

Alderman Robert Puente moved approval of the revocation based upon City Attorney testimony.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provided Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Chapters 90 and 108 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
- 2. Based upon the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the licensee, J. Jesus Gamez, has not met the criteria of Chapters 90 and 108 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances or Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes to allow the continued operation of the premises.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Licenses Committee that the full Common Council of the City of Milwaukee should exercise its judgment to revoke the Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses held by J. Jesus Gamez for the premises located at 1905 South 6th Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Palomas Place") based upon the evidence and testimony provided by the Milwaukee Police Department.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee, by a vote of five (5) ayes and zero (0) noes, recommends that the Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses held by J. Jesus Gamez for the premises located at 1905 South 6th Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Palomas Place") be revoked.
