## SUMMONS

The Public Safety Committee of the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee

You are hereby commanded to summon Cameron Radcliff, to appear before the Public Safety Committee of the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee at its meeting in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, in the City and County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin on Thursday, July 17, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. to show cause why the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's License issued to Cameron Radcliff should not be revoked or suspended.

Pursuant to Chapter 100 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Milwaukee, you are hereby commanded to appear on July 17, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. at a hearing before the City's Public Safety Committee to be held in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to show cause why your Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's License should not be revoked. The hearing is being initiated because of the City of Milwaukee's receipt of a complaint filed by the Milwaukee Police Department. A copy of the referenced complaint is attached hereto as well as a copy of Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

On July 17, 2008 at 9:00 a.m., you will be given an opportunity to speak on your own behalf, and to respond to and challenge any charges or reasons given by witnesses at the aforementioned hearing in support of a revocation or suspension of your license. You may present your own supporting witnesses, under oath, at this hearing, and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses. If you wish to do so, and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your own choosing to represent you at this hearing.

If you, Cameron Radcliff, fail to appear in person before the Committee on July 17, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 301-B, of City Hall, as required by the summons, the Committee will proceed to consider the allegations of the complaint, which allegations shall be taken as true. If the Committee determines that the allegations are sufficient, the law requires that the license shall be revoked or suspended.
