In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

The new light fixtures will be installed in the current 12 locations around the perimeter of the building. They will be sand colored to match the color of the brick and the new conduit will be painted to match the color of the brick. The new fixtures will illuminate straight down and not be shed onto adjacent properties. The lights will be on a timer to turn on at dusk.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 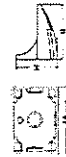




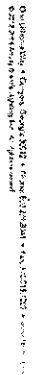
