You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 03/17/2015 officers went to Mil-Town Motors at 2072 S. 6th St regarding a complaint the business was operating without a valid Secondhand Motor Vehicle Dealer license, which expired 03/31/2014. Upon arrival the officers observed the business was open and had vehicles displayed for sale. Parminderjeet DHILLON identified himself as the owner. DHILLON was issued a citation for Secondhand Motor Vehicle License Required.
- 2. On 03/30/2015 officers went to Mil-Town Motors at 2072 S 6th St for follow up regarding a previously issued citation. The officers observed the business open with cars displayed for sale. Parminderjeet DHILLON was advised he needed a license to operate and he needed to remove signage and buyers guides from the autos. Officers returned on 03/31/2015 and found the business again open with vehicles displayed for sale and with no license issued. DHILLON was issued a citation for Secondhand Motor Vehicle License Required.
- 3. On 02/03/2016 officers responded to Mil-Town Motors at 2072 S 6th St regarding a complaint of them selling used autos without a license. Prior to going the officer checked LIRA and found no current license for that address with Inderjeet DHILLON holding the prior license which expired 03/31/2014. Upon arrival officers found 20 autos on the lot with 11 displaying sale prices and buyers guides. Parminderjeet DHILLON, who is the son of the previous licensee Inderjeet DHILLON, was contacted and stated because of back taxes his family could not get a seller permit from the state. Parminderjeet stated the tax issue has been resolved so he thought he could sell cars again. Later in the day Inderjeet DHILLON filed for a Secondhand

Motor Dealers License. Inderjeet DHILLON was issued a citation for Secondhand Motor Vehicle License Required.

This report is written by PO Penny BROWN, assigned to the Licensing Unit. On Monday, February 1, 2016, I was assigned to conduct follow up regarding an aldermanic complaint at 2072 S. 6th St. (Mil-Town Motors).

The complaint stated the agent and/or employees were selling or offering vehicles for sale on the lot, without a valid license. I confirmed via the LIRA System there was no current valid license to sell used motor vehicles for this location, and the last agent was Inderjeet S. DHILLON in 2012.

At approximately 10:50a.m., I conducted follow up at the lot and observed 20 cars on the lot, 11 of which had buyers guides with year and price stickers on them. I contacted Parminderjeet S. DHILLON A/M 01/16/86, who is known to me as DHILLON's son, and who has been running the lot.

Parminderjeet DHILLON stated his family owed the Department of Revenue back taxes and that is why they were unable to obtain a license. Parminderjeet stated they recently came to an agreement with DOR and were making monthly payments, therefore he thought it was ok to begin selling cars. Parminderjeet stated he knew they needed a license, however, thought the agreement with DOR would be sufficient.

Parminderjeet stated late in the afternoon on 02/03, Neal WILLIS (City of Milwaukee Department of Neighborhood Services) met with him and advised they still needed at license to sell vehicles, therefore, Parminderjeet went to City Hall and paid the required fee. I advised Parminderjeet paying the required fee still did not grant him a license and therefore, he could not sell any vehicles and would need to remove all buyers guides and price stickers from all the vehicles, until and if a license was granted to DHILLON.

I then checked the status of the license for the location and confirmed DHILLON applied for a license on 02/03/16. Parminderjeet also emailed me a copy of a receipt for a license showing an amount paid of \$315 on 02/03/16 at 4:13p.m., which was after I observed cars for sale on the lot.

PO DRAJKOWSKI advised the agent DHILLON that all signage on the vehicles including but not limited to the buyers guide were to be removed immediately as it still appeared they were

selling vehicles, to which DHILLON stated he understood and would comply.

On Tuesday, March 31, 2015, at approximately 12:30P, PO DRAJKOWSKI and I again returned and found 17 vehicles on the lot for sale and the business was open. Again the employees were advised all stickers and buyers guides needed to be removed immediately or they would be cited. At approximately 2:30P, officers returned to the establishment and found the signage to still be posted on the majority of the cars, and a patron on the lot, who appeared to have just test drove a vehicle. DHILLON was subsequently issued a citation for Secondhand Motor Vehicle License Required.

The above matter was heard before the Board of Zoning Appeals of the City of Milwaukee on October 7, 2010, based on an appeal from a determination of the Commissioner of City Development of the City of Milwaukee dated May 5, 2010, of a request for permit to continue occupying the premises as a motor vehicle sales and repair facility. A decision of the Board was rendered on October 7, 2010. The decision and the minutes were filed immediately thereafter in the office of the Board of Zoning Appeals pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, 62.23(7)(e)3.

IT IS FOUND:

That the Plan Examiner from the Department of City Development properly denied the request to continue occupying the premises as a motor vehicle sales and repair facility.

Special Uses are required by the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances for the following reasons:

295-603-1

A motor vehicle sales facility is a Special Use in a Local Business District.

295-603-1

A motor vehicle repair facility is a Special Use in a Local Business District.

The Board of Zoning Appea's concluded, after receiving the Notice of Appeal and Application for Review from the petitioner, and after due notice to the parties in interest, and having heard the evidence of the petitioner, interested parties, and the City of Milwaukee, and being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS CONCLUDED:

Based on the testimony heard by the Board, that the proposed Special Uses under Section 295-603-1 and 295-603-1 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances are consistent with:

- Protection of Public Health, Safety and Welfare.
 That the use is designed, located, and operated in a manner so that the public health safety and welfare is protected.
- 2. Protection of Property.

 That the use, value and enjoyment of other property in the neighborhood will not substantially impaired or diminished be the establishment, maintenance or operation of the special use.
- 3. Traffic and Pedestrian Safety.

 That adequate measures have been or will be taken to provide safe pedestrian and vehicular access.
- Consistency with Comprehensive Plan.
 That this special use will be designed, located and operated in a manner consistent with the city's comprehensive plan.

provided that the following conditions are complied with,

IT IS ORDERED AND DETERMINED:

On the hasis of the Findings Conclusions, and the record herein, that Special Use permits to continue occupying the premises as a motor vehicle sales and repair facility are hereby granted.

Subject to the following conditions:

- That the building and premises shall, in all other respects, comply with applicable building and zoning code regulations.
- 2. That any permits required to execute the approved plans be obtained within one (1) year of the date hereof.
- That the Plan of Operation and all plans as submitted to the Board, be fully complied with and
 maintained.
- That the building and premises shall, in all other respects, comply with applicable building and zoning code regulations.
- 2. That any permits required to execute the approved plans be obtained within one (1) year of the date hereof.
- That the Plan of Operation and all plans as submitted to the Board, be fully complied with and maintained.
- 4. That all repair work is conducted inside of the building.
- 5. That site illumination must meet the lighting standards of a 295-409 of the Milwaukee Zoning Code.
- That signage must theet the signage standards of s 295-605 of the Milwaukee Zoning Code.
- 7. That landscaping is maintained in a manner that meets the intent of the Milwaukee Zoning code.
- 8. That no work or storage of vehicles occurs in the public right of way.
- 9. That the applicant has no outdoor storage of auto parts, tires, nuisance vehicles or other junk and debris.
- That the applicant has no outdoor banners or other advertising except signage that has been approved and installed according to the requirements of a sign permit.

That these Special Uses are granted for a period of ten (10) years, commencing with the date 11.

That these Special Use permits are subject to revocation upon a finding that these conditions have not been fully complied with.


