DER, Employee Benefits, has received rates for dental services from the fee-for-service dental plan, Delta Dental, and from the three pre-paid dental plans, CarePlus, DentalBlue (Anthem) and First Commonwealth (Guardian).

This office recognizes there is a considerable increase in the rates from First Commonwealth for 2009. Employees will be able to make selections from among the four plans during open enrollment, and will be able to choose to move if the cost of the plan is not of value to the member. The City will contribute \$13 per month for single dental and \$37.50 per month for family dental, based on current labor contracts.
