Dear Alderman Bauman:

As a resident of Milwaukee and employee of Kraft Foods, I am writing to encourage your approval of Alderman Bohl's proposed resolution to "support efforts to discontinue federal corn ethanol mandates and cease incentives for corn ethanol production." This measure will be considered at the Judiciary and Legislative Committee hearing this afternoon.

As one of more than thirty Kraft employees in Milwaukee, we recognize that renewable energy and bio-fuels play an important role in sustainable energy for America – improving our energy security and enhancing the economic future of our children.
