You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on July 30, 2008 commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202 to consider the complaint of Police Sergeant Chester Ulickey seeking revocation of your public passenger vehicle driver's license.

Attached you will find a copy of the report of the Public Safety Committee which includes the Committee's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation, recommending suspension of your public passenger vehicle driver's license pending resolution of the charges against you.

You may file a written objection to the report of the Licenses Committee. Any written objections to the Committee's report must be filed with the City Clerk by 4:45 p.m. on July 25, 2008 in Room 205 of City Hall. You or a legal representative may then also appear at the Common Council meeting and request an opportunity to address the Common Council for approximately five (5) minutes to present an oral argument on your own behalf.
