

Ethanol Facts

Good for Wisconsin

- Each 40 million gallon plant puts \$113 million into local economy
- Adds dollars to rural economy through jobs and increased corn prices
- Each plant employs directly about 50 people at average salary of \$50,000

Good for Consumers

- Ethanol is over 1 dollar cheaper than gasoline per gallon
- E-10 use will save consumers an average of 10 cents per gallon
- Ethanol production reduces gasoline prices by 15% - saving the average family over \$500 per year – even after taking into consideration higher corn prices

Good for the Environment

E-10 reduces:

- Greenhouse gases by 19%
- Carbon Monoxide by up to 50%
- Particulate Matter by up to 36%
- Toxins like Benzene by 25%

Good for your Engine

- Ethanol is compatible with ALL engines sold in America
- Every Auto since about 1980 can burn E-10
- GM, Ford, Harley all *recommend* E-10
- Reformulated Gas in SE Wisconsin *is NOT* E-10

Good for America

- 64% of oil used in America is imported
- If all cars burned E-10 – we would need no more oil from Saudi Arabia
- If all cars burned E-85 – USA becomes a net oil exporter
