Attached please find a resolution which rescinds special privileges for which the items granted permission to encroach into the public right-of-way have either been removed to the satisfaction of the Commissioners of the Department of Neighborhood Services and the Department of Public Works or the public right-of-way vacated.

The Department of Public Works has been notified that the special privileges are no longer needed because the items permitted have been removed from the public right-of-way or the public right-of-way has been vacated.
